Before attending our service for the first time we require certain documents according to state laws and regulations.

#### Documents Needed:

#### Medical Action Plan

A medical action plan signed by a doctor is needed if you have a child with asthma, anaphylaxis, epilepsy, diabetes or other medical conditions.

#### Risk Minimisation Plan

This will be provided by staff on the day of arrival.

#### Dietary Plan

Provided by staff on the day. This includes food preferences and intolerances.

#### Medication:

If you have a child with a condition that requires medication such as asthma, anaphylaxis etc, we will need an in date medication within it's original packaging. We cannot accept loose medications.
