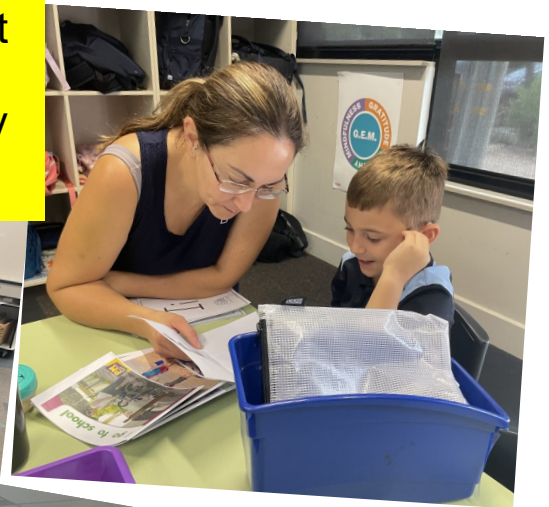
- A supportive and active school community who strive to create a vibrant and inclusive environment for our students to learn.

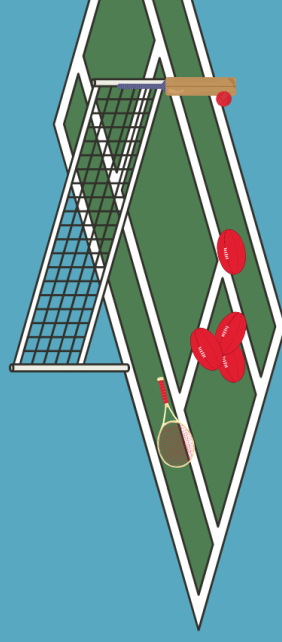
