

Dear Parents,

What do we look for in the National Simultaneous Storytime book?

Each year, interested publishers send in possible titles. From a practical perspective, the publisher has to be able and willing to provide copyright release for use of the illustrations, book projection, translation into other languages and performance. The publisher also needs to commit to a special print run of several thousand copies. This narrows down the options. The criteria for choosing from the remaining books include: a positive storyline; appeal to a modern and diverse audience; suitability for read-aloud (language and length); how well the book lends itself to craft and other activities.








Q. How can I remove unwanted items from my shopping cart?

- A. It is easy to remove or amend items in your shopping cart prior to paying for them.
- 1. Open Qkrl and tap 'Activity'.
 2. Under 'Active Carris tap on your school.
 3. Tap on the order or item you want to remove or update.
 4. Tap the garbage bin icon to remove the item from your cart;
- Tap the pencil icon to update or amend the item in your cart.



TIP OF THE WEEK

Q. What is the reason for having a child's photo on the Qkr! app?

If you choose to add your child's photo it will display at the top of the screen when you are provening styrook lerns on Qirl This feature is useful if you have multiple children at the same school. To select a different child when ordering, tep on the current child's photoframe and select another child.

This saves you time by allowing you to place orders for all your children with one transaction. There is no need to use the back button and no need to place separate orders for each child.

A. If you wish to add a photo of your child or if you have previously added a photo of your child and now you want to replace it with a different photo: on the Okr! app?

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
